Clarinet Fusion began in 2009 when four clarinet playing friends got together to play quartets. By 2012, more friends joined to form a full clarinet choir of nine, which includes the extended range of harmony clarinets (Eb Clarinet, Alto Clarinet and Contra Clarinets). Clarinet Fusion was featured in the San Francisco Symphony (SFS) community outreach program four consecutive years (2013-2016) until it disbanded. In 2018, Clarinet Fusion was honored with a 2017 Arts Recognition Award from the Contra Costa County Arts and Culture Commission and twice was selected to perform for the International Clarinet Association's annual ClarinetFest convention – in Reno, Nevada in 2022 and Dublin, Ireland in 2024. The group performs at least eight concerts yearly, playing a variety of musical styles spanning all genres of music, including premiere and commissioned works.
